Hazards	Risk	Existing Control	Further Action Required
Exit Routes	Not being able to exit in an emergency	A member of staff is present at all times Maximum of 10 people at any one time The door is never closed so people can exit quickly	
Materials of the Tent	Risk of Collapse	Made of a strong metal frame Tested Regularly	
Material of the Tent	Risk of Fire	Manufactured from 550g per Sq metre high quality, close mesh polyester, PU coated on the outside with a PVC coating on the inside to ensure fully waterproof Double stitched with reinforcing on stress areas All seams tape sealed Flame Retardant BS 7837 (with fire certificate) No Electricity in the tent, all lighting is battery operated	If a fire takes places people would follow the usual school / centres procedures

Safeguarding	Safeguarding	All Voyager Staff are CRB checked Safety briefing beforehand	Ongoing CRB checks
COVID-19	Safeguarding – risk of COVID transmission	Hand sanitizer used before entering the tent	
COVID-19	Safeguarding – risk of COVID transmission	Cleaning and disinfecting the site and equipment before & after every use	Ongoing after every use
COVID-19	Safeguarding – risk of COVID transmission	Limit number to 6 (usually 8-10)	
COVID-19	Safeguarding – risk of COVID transmission	Face masks worn inside the tent at all times	
COVID-19	Safeguarding – risk of COVID transmission	Tent door will be left open at all times to allow for ventilation	
COVID-19	Safeguarding – risk of COVID transmission	Animateur will do briefing outside the tent and allow students to enter on their own. The Animateur will go no further than the door.
